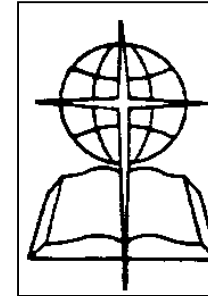

Camp News

It's summer again and that means camp is right around the corner! This year's theme is centered around Revelation 3:20. We will be emphasizing how the Holy Spirit is always here knocking at our door! "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me." Jesus is always calling us into His arms and into His kingdom. It is up to us to accept His invitation and have a growing relationship with our Savior.

This year camp has a couple schedule changes. Kids camp will begin on **Saturday**, July 20th and last until **Tuesday**, July 23rd. Youth camp will begin on Wednesday, July 24th (like normal) and last until Sunday the 28th. The only schedule change to youth camp is the pick up time has been pushed back to 2:00 pm, rather than noon; that way transportation leaders do not have to leave during Sunday services.

Additionally, we would like churches to be aware that Midlakes Camps is asking for financial help. A donation drive has been created in hopes to raise money for the following three categories: Camp Improvement, Student Scholarship, General Funds.

+ Camp Improvement money will go directly to pouring into our camp facility, Baptist Ridge Camp. They are currently in need of financial help because they have one unusable cabin that must be rebuilt soon or we are going to run out of beds at camp! Any money donated to the camp improvements fund will help our camp facility continue to be able to house our growing number of students.

+ Student Scholarship money will simply be used to send kids to camp who cannot afford to go on their own.

+ General Funds is set aside for financial needs that come up as we plan and prepare for camp. Examples of how this money would be used is: purchasing recreation supplies, getting gas for the Midlakes Shuttle, or buying ink to print lesson materials.

Any money given to camp is tax refundable. When you donate to Midlakes, you will receive a thank you/tax letter for your records. We ask that you would prayerfully consider giving to Midlakes Camps this summer. Thank you!
