and participated in the National Day of Prayer Rally at FBC in Bolivar. I attended our Camp Ministry Meeting, and hosted an Associational Council Meeting where the leaders of the association gathered to look at the work of the association. I also enjoyed the time spent together with brethren at our Pastors / Men's Breakfast which we have twice a month on the first and third Tuesdays at 8:30 AM at Brenda's Café. These blankets, quilts, and carrying bags will be distributed through the Disaster Relief Ministry to children and families who have faced a disaster. The goal is for every child to have their own blanket. Thank you WMU ladies. While there I met with the State Director for MBC Disaster Relief and we took at look at our association Disaster Relief work and the state's DR work, and I toured the state's new feeding unit. While putting this newsletter together, I was interrupted by the tornado that hit Bolivar. At my house, we had half a tree down and a patch of shingles blown off the roof all the way to bare wood. Contacts are being made to see if anyone needs assistance. On Monday (Memorial Day) a group of people from the association helped clear a yard for one lady who has been a great volunteer in our association. If anyone knows of someone needing help in clearing debris, please let us know.

The summer months are always busy, and full of activities. There are so many opportunities for us to serve our Lord during this time. Be strong, be faithful, and be available, and let the Lord do the rest.


Annual Baptist Home-Ozark Charity Golf June 25 @ 8:00 am
