July has been a very busy month. I continue to be blessed to be invited to speak in many of our churches. Our Executive Board Meeting had a good attendance with a majority of our churches being represented. It was a time of celebration, challenging insights, and excitement over what God is providing and doing. During the meeting we established the "Joe Coppedge Camp Scholarship Fund", so no camper would ever be denied the opportunity to attend camp because of finances. This fund came about by a donation of \$5,000 from Ms. Judy Coppedge. She said Joe loved camp, and she wanted to make sure his legacy in camp continues. THANK YOU Ms. Judy. We also received a \$2,000 donation to the Kayak Ministry. A designated budget line has been created for the Kayak

Ministry. We also entered into an agreement with SBU to be able to park our Disaster Relief equipment, shuttle, and kayak trailer in a secure lot on the SBU campus. Another exciting result of this meeting was the establishment of a designated budget line where people can give to the creation of a new Block Party Trailer for the association. This trailer would be available for churches to check out and use in their church events and community outreach. It would consist of things like a bounce house, throw games, pop up tents, a three door evangelism tool, coolers, popcorn popper, sno-cone machine, and more.

One difficult hurdle was conquered during July, I finally passed my CDL test for driving the shuttle.

Camp this year was fabulous! Our camp committee and camp directors did an outstanding job, not only planning, but praying through all the details about camp. Three children and five youth gave their hearts to the Lord during camp, and many others made decisions to dedicate their lives to service to the Lord in one way or another. We also had two baptisms while there. This year our camp committee wanted to give the love offering to the Sanderson Family who just left for language school in TX to prepare them for the mission field in Mexico. Usually the camp offering runs \$100—\$200 dollars. However, we realized that there is another family from our association who also just left for the mission field. Bro. Billy Glover, who served as the interim DOM before I came, just left to be a church planter in Ohio. So instead of dividing the offering between the two families, we felt that the association could match whatever was taken for the Sanderson's and send that amount to the Glover Family also. We felt this was what God would have us to do. To our surprise, but not to God's, the kids and youth collected \$700 this year! Wow, that is amazing. So we feel it is only right that we keep our commitment and send the Glover Family a \$700 love offering from the association to support their church plant ministry in OH. You know the great thing about it, whenever we are willing to give to the work of the Lord with an open hand, God always blesses. So join us in praising God for all He is doing through the Mid Lakes Baptist Association. Please check out the rest of the newsletter for other upcoming events.

Thank you so much for all your prayers and support as we continue to acclimate to our new roll as AMS. May I say we love it and are quickly falling in love with the churches of the association.




