Missions and Ministry Together

Hello Mid Lakes Family.

As I write this article, I am reminded of an Old Testament passage which is one of the greatest miracles in the Old Testament. **Nehemiah 4:6** says, "So we built the wall, and the entire wall was joined together up to half its height, for the people had a mind to work." To me the building of the wall was not the great miracle, but the unity in which God's people joined together and worked together for the honor and glory of God. One thing that all the people did that made this possible, was they did not allow themselves to be distracted from the mission at hand. Even with the enemy coming against them, they did not stop working together for the Lord. Each person actively did their part, and had they not worked together, they would not have succeeded.

Today we as Southern Baptist find ourselves at a crossroads. After an intense investigation, it has been discovered that a few Southern Baptist leaders have "covered up" (or ignored) the sinful, lustful behavior of some in the ministry. Without a doubt sexual predators need to be held accountable and those who have been preyed upon need to be ministered to. No doubt, at this year's SBC Annual Meeting, the process will begin of how to prevent this from happening again, and what measures need to be put in place to make sure the cause of Christ faces no more disgrace.

However, I again want to remind us of a few things.

- Southern Baptist working together have made a difference because of the way we cooperatively work together.
- Probably 95% of the great things happening in the SBC are seldom talked about, but the 5% (or less) of negative things get most of the attention.
- We cannot allow a handful of people to ruin what God has put together over the past 177 years.
- One person told me this week, "We need to remember that we are still stronger together". They are so right.
- Do Southern Baptist have problems? Sure we do because we have human beings involved, but we are still the strongest denomination when it comes to evangelism, humanitarian aid ministries, and in sending out missionaries.
- Don't forget about doctrine. Southern Baptist stand strong on the Word of God and what God says.

I want to encourage all of you, DON'T JUMP SHIP, but do the opposite, become more involved! Make a difference. We live in a sinful world full of distractions and sin. Choose to be part of something where you can make a positive eternal difference. That includes being faithful (and even more faithful) to the church God has placed you in. A sweet lady told me this week, "I think one problem is we don't hear preachers preaching about sin anymore". Sadly, she has a point. It is the acceptance of sin which has brought about moral failure in our nations, and in our denomination. Let's raise the bar back up. Let's call sin, sin. Let's devote ourselves to God and God's Word instead of the world.

I also want to remind you that instead of harboring a condemning spirit, let's pray for those who have fallen. Let's restore those who have fallen and remember that we are just as capable of falling into temptation as they are.

I praise God for the churches of our association, and I truly believe that we are stronger together. So let's pray for one another, encourage, and help one another so the kingdom of Heaven can be expanded.



Ephesians Chapter 4

- **4** I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, ² with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, ³ endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴ *There is* one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.
- ⁷But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. ⁸Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men."
- ⁹ (Now this, "He ascended"—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? ¹⁰ He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)
- ¹¹ And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, ¹² for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, ¹³ till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; ¹⁴ that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, ¹⁵ but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ— ¹⁶ from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.
- ¹⁷ This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as ¹the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, ¹⁸ having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; ¹⁹ who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.
- ²⁰ But you have not so learned Christ, ²¹ if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: ²² that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, ²³ and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, ²⁴ and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.
- ²⁵ Therefore, putting away lying, "Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another. ²⁶ "Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath, ²⁷ nor give place to the devil. ²⁸ Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with *his* hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need. ²⁹ Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. ³⁰ And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. ³¹ Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, ¹ clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. ³² And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.






Monthly Men's Fellowship Breakfast
