God has provided a great opportunity for Crossroads Baptist Association pastors to participate in a Mexico mission trip, October 9<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup>, 2022. This would be an opportunity for our pastors to connect with one another while serving our Lord Jesus Christ.

Casas Por Cristo has been around since 1993. They build homes for low-income families in Mexico, Dominican Republic, Guatemala and Nicaragua. Their stated purpose is to open the door for local pastors and churches to share the love of Jesus Christ by serving. On average, each of their builds sees 2 salvations.

CBA pastors have been given the opportunity to participate in a Legacy build. The cost per individual is literally the cost of traveling down and back and the food while traveling. We would leave Sunday afternoon October 9th from FBC Moberly, stay Sunday night in a hotel or host church and travel the rest of the way down Monday. Tuesday-Thursday we would build one house. Friday October 14<sup>th</sup>, we will begin the drive home staying in a hotel or host church that evening arriving home Saturday. Food and housing are provided once we arrive on site.
