Whenever the church sets her focus on being like Jesus, then she is headed in the right direction. That means we sometimes have to ask ourselves the hard questions. That means we have to hold one another accountable in love. That means we may have to walk away from some things which are present in our lives in order for God to use us to our fullest potential. That means we may need to change who we are and how we do things. To sum it up, that means the church needs Revival.

Whenever we use the word Revival, most people think, "Oh, that is when we have a series of meetings and people come to get saved". However, this is not the true definition of Revival. Can people get saved at a Revival service? Yes, but true Revival is for the church. Lost people are dead in their sin. You cannot revive what has never been alive spiritually. That's a spiritual awakening and a miracle from God. Revival is when God's people (the saved), make the time to draw closer to God through the power of the Holy Spirit. Spiritually speaking, a lot of people have lost their spiritual spark. 
