PLEASE READ Hispanic Ministry Update

On August 16, 2023, five people met at the association office to discuss the possible need for a Hispanic work in the Bolivar and surrounding areas. One month later we met again, along with some other leaders, and a plan was developed to host a Block Party for the Hispanic Community. On September 15th multiple people worked together to host a Hispanic Block Party. Through this effort, between 75—100 Hispanics attended the Block Party. The next Monday evening a Hispanic Bible study began with two people from the community attending. Now lets fast forward to today. Each Monday evening at 7 PM, a group of 20-25 Hispanics meet to study God's Word and fellowship. This group has developed into a good core group who have a passion for following Jesus.

Preparations are being made now for the NEXT STEP in the process. On May 22, 2024 I met with those who have helped lead the Bible studies and Pastor Rodriguez to discuss the next step of faith for the Hispanic Ministry and the association. I will try my best to explain this in bullet points.

- Plans are in the works to begin a Hispanic Worship Service very soon. Some people will attend a worship service who might not attend a Bible study.
- A young man by the name of **Hebel (pronounced A-bell) Gutierrez**, who has been leading many of the Bible studies, will become the coordinator and will begin the process of completing the NAMB Church Planter Training. During this six month process, this young man (in his upper 20's) will be working around 20 hours per week to help build the worship services and to reach out to the Hispanic community. He also will still be leading the Bible Study. During this time, we as an association of churches and individuals will have the opportunity to invest in his ministry. For this to happen, we must get involved. Because he and his wife currently live in Springfield, he will be driving two days a week for the Bible study and worship service, but he will also be here a lot of other days. Because of this, he will have expenses. For the first six months, we need to help provide \$500 a month for fuel and \$200 a month for other expenses. For example, he might take someone to lunch for the purpose of sharing the gospel. He will be under the oversight of Pastor Rodriguez, and we will also be appointing a committee to work with Pastor Rodriguez.
- After six months as coordinator, and the completion of his NAMB training, Hebel will be evaluated and if he feels this is where God wants him to serve, and if the committee recommends it, along with Pastor Rodriguez, then Hebel will be promoted to church planter. At this point NAMB will kick in some funds, (possibly up to \$1,000), but we would need to kick in some more to make his being on the field full time possible. The goal is to help the church grow so it can become self sufficient. The goal is for the church plant to become self sufficient as soon as possible. Anytime within the first five years.
- How can YOU be a part? 1 If each church gives some, this goal can be easily met. Different size churches will give different
 amounts, and that's OK. Give as God directs your church. We also have many individuals in our churches who would love to
 support this ministry. Please help encourage this. This is all a step of faith, and I am excited to see how God is putting all the
 pieces together.
- I would like to say "Thank You" to FBC, Bolivar for taking the lead in supporting this ministry. They not only have allowed the Bible study group to use their facility each week to meet in, but have also provided coffee and refreshments and made this group feel welcome. Don Hodson and Gustavo Nix have been instrumental in supporting this ministry. It helps that they speak Spanish.
- As soon as they begin the church plant status, they will petition the association to be a church plant of the association. Pastor Rodrigeuz has stressed how important it is for us to teach who Southern Baptist are and why.
- So here is what we need to pray for:
 - 1 For God to provide the right place and time for the worship services to begin.
 - 2 For God to direct each church in how they can help. If financially, then how much?
 - 3 For God to place this ministry on the hearts of individuals. God can also use individuals to help finance this ministry.
 - 4 For God to be glorified in everything we do. They already have individuals wishing to be baptized. How exciting!!

Thank you for your prayers and support. I love watching people carry out the Great Commission together!!!!

Some churches have already pledged monthly support. We will share more after the July Executive Board Meeting.




