Greetings from Mid Lakes Baptist Association.

Over the past month we have all experienced the force of nature when it comes to feeling like we were in an ice box covered in snow. For those who love snow, it was great. My grandkids loved being out of school. However, for many, the cold winter months bring about a feeling of captivity and depression. I also know our churches can



go through times when we feel discouraged and depressed. I personally have been there and understand these feelings.

Last Sunday (2/23/25) I visited Caplinger Mills Baptist Church and listened to Bro. Harry Morre share a message dealing with these very issues. For in 1 Samual 30, David and his men return to Ziklag and found their families had been taken captive by the Amalekites and Ziklag had been burned by fire. These men found themselves feeling defeated. Verse 4 says, "*Then David and the people who were with him lifted up their voices and wept, until they had no more power to weep.*" I would expect I would do the very same thing. However, Bro. Harry brought our something in this passage that I had not really thought about. In verse 6 David was very distressed, and so were the people. Some even thought about storning David. However, in the last part of that verse we see something that is amazing in itself. *"...But David strengthened himself in the Lord his God."* Somewhere David had to have a serious conversation with himself, look at things from God's perspective, listen to what God had said and was still saying, and you might say he reached down and picked himself up by his own bootstraps! Sure it was with God's help, but it had to start with David refocusing himself on God directions.

Just recently I spoke with someone concerning a situation, and all I heard was the words, "but what I want is....". Never once was their mention of what God's will was. Be sure not to fall into the "I" trap. For "I" is the center of "s(i)n". God is still on the throne, and He still has a plan. Sometimes (actually, oftentimes) His plans do not look like our plans, but that's OK. Follow His plan. Focus on God, pull up your spiritual bootstraps, and strengthen yourself in the Lord.

Now just a reminder, even though it may feel like winter (discouraging times) will never end, spring is coming. A fresh look, fresh perspective, and fresh filling of the Lord can take us in to spring, especially the spring of service and seeking God's will.

Thank you Bro. Happy for reminding me to talk to myself, and for all of me to seek the Lord in all things.

Wellspring has applied for membership in the Mid Lakes Baptist Association.


Our commitment is to:





# Empowering Safe Environments for Churches

We've been hard at work revamping our Child Safety Training Program to ensure it meets the highest standards and addresses key safety concerns.

On January 21, we will be releasing all new Volunteer and Staff versions of our Child Safety Training with updated statistics, graphics and guides.

Less than 38% of child victims disclose they've been abused. It is critical that our program empower churches to mitigate potential incidents by recognizing the signs of abuse and grooming early.

Our mission at Protect My Ministry is to provide you with the tools and services to make your church a safe haven for worship. Our employee training is approved by the Texas Department of State Health Services for child sexual abuse prevention. At the end of each training participants must pass a quiz with at least a 70% to earn a Certificate of Completion. An updated Spanish version will also be available.


